From the Salton Sea, it runs northwest 800 miles before it ends under the Pacific Ocean. The San Andreas Fault is known as a transformation defect, where you meet two dishes of the earth. Yet almost everyone has seen the classic image of the San Andreas fault taken from the air of the Carrizo Plain. In Soda Lake, the fault runs right at the bottom of the hill beyond the water. Geologists have gone mad about this piece of California geology. In addition to the dramatic fault, a bird-flight view reveals beds of torrents that have been compensated by the movement of the fault, broken hills in the middle and fragments of the earth's surface. These features are thinner and more difficult to see on the ground. However, the area is exceptionally beautiful, especially during the year of wild flowers in spring and summer. The free and self-guided brochure of the geological tour is available online or at the visitor centre and will help you get the most out of your visit. With an estimated magnitude of about 8 on the Richter scale, in 1989 it was almost 10 times larger than the magnitude of 7.1. In the center about two miles off, he broke the San Andreas Fault for almost 300 miles and was heard from Oregon to Los Angeles. The devastating fires broke out in his aftermath. More than 3,000 people have died, which has been the greatest loss of life from a natural disaster in California history. Statistics are eye-popping: 200,000 people were homeless from 410,000 in the city. About 25,000 buildings were destroyed, and there were \$400 million in losses (an equivalent to \$14.4 billion in 2020). Surprisingly, the city has returned to its feet in a few years, in time to host the International Panama-Pacific Exhibition of 1915.
