Some buses might pass by different stops and dont directly head to Ajman; in such cases, you can easily take a taxi or another bus. RTA buses offer you a comfortable trip due to their air conditioning system and high-quality Mountains following the Sharjah-Kalba Road to get to the enclave of Masfout. Non-GCC Nationals should ensure that they have their passports with them as some routes cross into Omani territory though you are unlikely to be asked. You can visit Masfout as part of a day trip to Hatta (a Dubai enclave). The main attraction here is the Masfout Castle and stunning mountains and wadi views along the way. If you are travelling from Abu Dhabi International Airport (AUH) to Ajman, the journey is 155kms and will take around 1 hour and 50 minutes, dependent on traffic through Dubai and Sharjah on the E11 or E311. There is no direct public transport link between Abu Dhabi and Dubai, but you can follow our guide here to getting between Abu Dhabi and Sharjah and look to connect from Sharjah to Ajman. If you are looking to travel beyond Ajman to Ras Al Khaimah, there is a service that picks up from Liwara Station at the northern end of Sheikh Rashid bin Humaid Street. It is the smallest of the emirates by area. Ajman is located on the Arabian Gulf and is surrounded by the emirate of Sharjah. The capital city of Ajman is also called Ajman. The cities of Dubai, Sharjah, and Ajman are all a part of the Dubai-Sharjah-Ajman metropolitan area (DSA), a single urban area. Ajman is home to many expatriates that work in Dubai. Union Square Bus Station is located in the Deira area of Dubai. The service terminates at Al Musalla Bus Station in Ajman city centre. The fare from Union Square Bus Station to Al Musalla Bus Station is 12 AED (2.41, 2.77, \$3.27). Buses run every day from early morning to late at night. The total travel time is around 50 minutes under normal traffic conditions. Union Square Bus Station is close to Union Metro Station. Union Metro Station is a transfer station (on both the Red Line and the Green Line of the Dubai Metro). Red Line trains run between Expo 2020 Metro Station and Centrepont Metro Station (previously called Rashidiya Metro Station). Stops on the route include Dubai International Airport. The E411 bus service departs from Etisalat Bus Station. Etisalat Bus Station is located in the Al Qusais area of Dubai. The service terminates at Al Musalla Bus Station in Ajman city centre. Buses run every day of the week. The ticket price from Etisalat Bus Station to Al Musalla Bus Station is 12 AED. The journey time is around 40 minutes. Etisalat Bus Station is connected to Etisalat Metro Station. Etisalat Metro Station is on the Green Line. The cost of travelling from Dubai to Ajman using public bus services is fairly cheap, especially when compared to the cost of taking a taxi. Fares are paid using Nol Cards (contactless public transportation cards). Nol Cards can be purchased and topped up at any Dubai Metro station or Dubai Bus station. Although the bus is not the fastest way to travel between Dubai and Ajman, it is certainly the cheapest.
