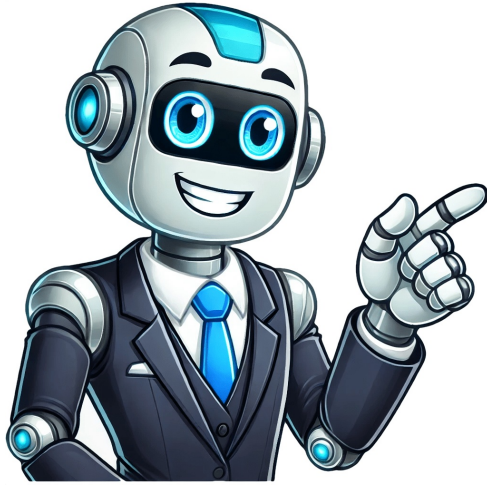

In the United States, the Age of Consent is the legal age at which an individual is considered mature enough to consent to sex. Sexual relations with someone under the Age of Consent are considered statutory rape, even (in some jurisdictions), if both partners are themselves younger than the Age of Consent. There are a total of 31 states have set their age of consent at 16, the lowest age of consent in any state. In Washington, a person is guilty of rape of a child in the third degree when the person has sexual intercourse with another who is at least fourteen years old but less than sixteen years old and not married to the perpetrator and the perpetrator is at least forty-eight months older than the victim. Rape of a child in the third degree is a class C felony. A person is guilty of rape of a child in the second degree when the person has sexual intercourse with another who is at least twelve years old but less than fourteen years old and not married to the perpetrator and the perpetrator is at least thirty-six months older than the victim. Rape of a child in the second degree is a class A felony. Finally, A person is guilty of rape of a child in the first degree when the person has sexual intercourse with another who is less than twelve years old and not married to the perpetrator and the perpetrator is at least twenty-four months older than the victim. Rape of a child in the first degree is a class A felony. Washington has no Close-In-Age Exemption There are no set close-in-age exemptions or "Romeo and Juliet laws" to Washington's age of consent law. This means that anyone who engages in sexual activity with someone under the age of consent in Washington is liable for prosecution, including people only a few years older then their sexual partner and even two individuals who are both under the age of consent. What is the Age of Consent? The Age of Consent is the age at which a person is deemed by Washington law to be capable of consenting to, and engaging in, sexual acts. Anyone who engages in sexual activity of any type with a partner under the applicable Age of Consent is breaking the law and can be charged with crimes ranging from a misdemeanor to a felony (statutory rape) depending on the jurisdiction in which they are prosecuted. Washington's specific laws on the Age of Consent can be found above. What happens if i violate the Washington Age of Consent? If you engage in sexual activity with a minor who is under the Washington Age of Consent of 18, you can be prosecuted under Washington sexual abuse laws and charged with crimes ranging from sexual assault or statutory rape to first degree rape, regardless of whether or not the sexual acts were consensual. Depending on the charges, conviction can carry penalties ranging from one to fifty years in prison and registration as a sex offender. Does the Washington Age of Consent apply to explicit pictures or videos? It is important to note that Washington's Age of Consent does not apply to "sexting", or transmission of explicit photos or videos. Producing or receiving explicit photos of minors (any person under age 18) is illegal in Washington, and all other states, under child pornography laws. Because the Washington Age of Consent is 16 years old, while minors between the ages of 16 and 18 may be allowed to consent to sexual intercourse, sharing of explicit images - even with someone else under age 18 - may be subject to criminal prosecution. Possession of explicit images of an underage person is also illegal under Federal law, and while minors are not typically prosecuted for possession, adults are frequently prosecuted for producing, possessing, receiving, or distributing underage pornography. The Ohio Age of Consent is 16 years old. (A) No person who is eighteen years of age or older shall engage in sexual conduct with another, who is not the spouse of the offender, when the offender knows the other person is thirteen years of age or older but less than sixteen years of age, or the offender is reckless in regard, 2907.02 (A) 1. No person shall engage in sexual conduct with another person who is not the spouse of the offender or who is the spouse of the offender but is living separate and apart from the offender when any of the following applies. (b) The other person is less than thirteen years of age, whether or not the offender knows the age of the other person Punishments for Violating the Age Of Consent in Ohio Ohio has five statutory sexual abuse charges on the books which are used to prosecute age of consent and child abuse related crimes within the state. One or more of these charges may be used to prosecute violations of the Ohio Age of Consent, as statutory rape or the Ohio equivalent of that charge. The severity of the criminal charge (felony, misdemeanor, etc) depends on the specifics of the acts committed and the relative ages of the perpetrator and victim. In some of the countries, especially in Arab region there is no legal age of consent but all sexual relations are forbidden outside of marriage. The laws were designed to prosecute people older than the victims rather than teenagers close in age. The lowest age of consent is 9 years for Maldives and 12 years for Angola, Mexico, Philippines, South Sudan and Sudan, which is the minimum age in the world. The youngest age of consent varies from the ages from 9 to 21, but the most common consent around the world ranges from 14 years to 16 years.The age of consent in the United States varies from 16 to 18. The age of consent in Europe vary by jurisdiction. They are currently set between the ages of 14 and 18. The vast majority of countries set their ages in the range of 14 to 16, and only other three countries, Cyprus (17), Ireland (17), Turkey (18) has their own pattern. The legal age of consent in Africa for sexual activity varies from 12 to 21, ranging from age 12 in Sudan to age 21 in Cameroon and Niger. The legal age of consent in North America relating to sexual activity varies by jurisdiction. Each U.S. state has set its age of consent at either age 16, age 17, or age 18. The age of consent in Canada is 16. The age of consent in South America varies by jurisdiction, codified in laws which may also stipulate the specific activities that are permitted or the gender of participants for different ages. Across South America it varies from 14 to 18. Lowest age of consent The lowest age of consent in the world is 9 years for Maldives and 12 years for Angola, Mexico, South Sudan, Philippines and Sudan, which is the minimum age of consent in the world. The age of consent in Africa varies from 11 to 18 years old and the lowest age of consent in europe is 14, applies in countries including Germany, Austria, Italy, Serbia and Portugal, while other some of the european countries set age from 16 to 17 as the age of consent, several others, including Malta and Vatican City, require age of consent to be at least 18. The age of consent in North America varies by jurisdiction, with the lowest being 16 and the highest being 18 years old. It is worth noting the North American countries that in both United States and Canada, engaging in sexual activity with a minor below the age of consent is considered statutory rape and is punishable by law. The age of consent in South America varies by country with the lowest age of consent being 13 and the highest being 18 years old. Age of Consent in United States The age of consent in the United States varies from 16 to 18 years old depending on the state. In some jurisdictions, Sexual activity between all-underaged participants can also be regarded as statutory rape. Out of fifty States, Thirty-one states set the age of consent as 16, eight set it as 17, and eleven set it as 18 as age of consent. Even eligibility of playing lottery in US is 18 years. Age of Consent in Canada According to the The Tackling Violent Crime Act took effect on 1 May 2008, raising the age of consent in Canada from 14 to 16. The close-in-age exemptions are depending on the age. A youth of twelve or thirteen can consent to sexual activity with a person less than two years older or a fourteen or fifteen year old can consent to sexual activity with a partner who is less than five years older. Age of Consent in FranceThe age of consent in France is 15, as specified by Article 227-25 of the Penal Code. The act of sexual assault on a minor under the age of fifteen for an adult is punishable by seven years imprisonment and a fine of 100,000. Age of Consent in JapanAccording to the Penal Code of Japan in 1907, The age of consent in Japan sets a national age of 13. As per the general law of 1907, Any sexual activity with a person under 13 is considered to be statutory rape and can result in a prison sentence of up to 20 years. But the age of consent in Japan varies significantly across the country. There are three set of laws like Juvenile Obscene Acts, Civil laws and the penal code. Each of these sets out different guidelines as to when sexual activity is acceptable. Its illegal to marry a person below 20 years without parent's permission in the written format. Youth protection law states it is illegal for a adult to have sex who is under 17 years old. Age of Consent in MexicoAccording to the federal law, The minimum age of consent in Mexico is 12 to 15 as per the state laws, while the age at which there are no restrictions for consensual sexual activities is 16 to 18 depends on the state laws, which says sex with someone 12 to 18 is not illegal but local state laws may override the federal law. Mexico States with minimum age of consent of 12 years is Aguascalientes, Baja California Sur, Guerrero, Mexico City, Michoacán, Morelos, Sinaloa, Sonora, Tamaulipas, and Zacatecas, and Nuevo León age of consent is 13 years. States with minimum age of consent of 14 years is Baja California, Campeche, Chiapas, Chihuahua, Colima, Durango, Guanajuato, Querétaro, Quintana Roo, San Luis Potosi and Tlaxcala. Mexico States with minimum age of consent of 15 years are Coahuila, Hidalgo, México and Yucatán. Age of Consent in GermanyThe age of consent in Germany is 14, as long as a person over the age of 21 does not exploit a 14 to 15 year old person due to lack of capacity for sexual self determination. Its offense young people to have sex with children younger than 14, but if two children engage in sexual acts with each other, they will not be punished since they have not reached the age of criminal responsibility in Germany. So the young people aged 14 and 15 are allowed to have sex with each other if they are consent to each other. Adults aged 21 and over are not allowed to exploit young people under the age of 16, and 18 or over are to be considered adults in Germany, can therefore have sex with other adults if both people consent. Age of Consent in South KoreaThe age of consent in South Korea, sexual activity with a person under the age of 16 in international age, not Korean age, is considered sexual rape, unless the other party is under 19. South Korea has set one of the oldest ages of consent in the world. Previously, the age of consent in South Korea was 13, one of the lowest in the world. South Korea has a traditional system of counting the age who is 12 years old as 13 years old. The age of consent in ChinaThe age of consent in China for sexual activity is 14 years, regardless of gender or sexual orientation. Nigeria: Age of consent in Nigeria is 18 years, According to Section 31 (3) (a) of the Child's Rights Act 2003 states that, Where a person is charged with an offence (of unlawful sexual relations with a child) under this section (31 of the same act), it is immaterial that the offender believed the person to be of or above the age of eighteen years. Denmark: The age of consent in the Kingdom of Denmark is 15 years as specified by Section 222, Whoever has sexual intercourse with a child under the age of 15, shall be punished by imprisonment for up to 8 years. According to section 223, Any person who has sexual intercourse with any child under 18, who is said person's adopted child, stepchild or foster child, or who is entrusted to said person for education or upbringing, they will be liable to imprisonment for any term not exceeding four years.Belgium: The age of consent in Belgium is 16, as specified by Article 372 of the Criminal Code. Bulgaria: The age of consent in Bulgaria is 14, as specified by Articles 149 and 151. Czech Republic: The age of sexual consent in the Czech Republic is 15. Greece: As specified by Article 339, as well as Articles 337, 348B of the Greek Penal Code, The age of consent in Greece is 15. Romania: The age of consent in Romania is 16, according to the Romanian Criminal Code. Norway: The age of consent in Norway is 16, as specified by the 2005 Penal Code. Georgia: The age of consent in Georgia is 16 as per the Georgian Penal Code. Hungary: The age of consent in Hungary is 14. A close-in-age exemption allows sexual acts from age 12 if the older party is under 18. Croatia: The age of consent in Croatia for all sexual conduct under the Criminal Code and regulated by Article 158 as on January 2013 is 15. Peru: According to the Constitutional Court Peru the age of consent was fixed at 14, regardless of gender or sexual orientation. Jamaica: The age of consent in Jamaica is 16. According to Article 50, Above twelve and under sixteen are Offenses against the person. Iceland: The age of consent in Iceland is 15, as specified by Section 202 of the Icelandic Penal Code. Poland: The age of consent in Poland is 15, as specified by the Polish Penal Code, Article 200. Switzerland: The age of consent in Switzerland is 16, as specified by the Swiss Federal Criminal Code, Article 187. Hong Kong: The age of consent in Hong Kong for sexual activity is 16 regardless of gender or sexual orientation. However, the age of consent for a female receiving anal sex is 21. Brazil: The age of consent in Brazil is 14, regardless of gender or sexual orientation, there is judicial precedent allowing a close-in-age exception for those aged between 12 to 13 to engage in sexual activity with partners who are as much as 5 years older. Venezuela: Sexual acts with children are punished under Art. 375, 379 of the penal code. The age of consent in Venezuela is 16, regardless of gender or sexual orientation. Finland: The age of consent in Finland is 16, as specified by Section 6. A person who has sexual intercourse with a child younger to sixteen years of age shall be sentenced for sexual abuse of a child to imprisonment for up to four years. Argentina: The age of Consent in Argentina is 18. Sexual acts with children younger than 13 are illegal and Sexual relations with teens 13 to 18 are addressed by several laws. Israel: The age of consent in Israel is 16 regardless of gender or sexual orientation according to the Israeli Penal Code of 1977. New Zealand: The age of consent in New Zealand is 16, It is an offense in New Zealand to have a sexual connection with a person under the age of 16. The Arkansas Age of Consent is 16 years old. In the United States, the age of consent is the minimum age at which an individual is considered legally old enough to consent to participation in sexual activity. Individuals aged 15 or younger in Arkansas are not legally able to consent to sexual activity, and such activity may result in prosecution for statutory rape. Arkansas statutory rape law is violated when a person has consensual sexual intercourse with an individual under age 16. If the offender is under age 18, the younger party must not be under 14 years of ageIf defense exists if the younger party is at no more than 4 years younger than the offender, or no more than 3 years younger if the victim is under 12). View list of sexual assault laws & punishments in Arkansas The age of consent in Arkansas is based on the following statutes from the Arkansas criminal code: Arkansas Age Of Consent Law: 5-14-127. A person commits sexual assault in the fourth degree if the person: (a) (1) Being twenty (20) years of age or older, engages in sexual intercourse or deviate sexual activity with another person who is: (A) Less than sixteen (16) years of age; and (B) Not the person's spouse; or (2) Engages in sexual intercourse with another person who is: (A) Less than sixteen (16) years of age; and (B) Not the person's spouse. (b) (1) Sexual assault in the fourth degree under subdivision (a)(1) of this section is a Class D felony. (2) Sexual assault in the fourth degree under subdivision (a)(2) of this section is a Class A misdemeanor if the person engages only in sexual intercourse with another person as described in subdivision (a)(2) of this section. Punishments for Violating the Age Of Consent in Arkansas Arkansas has nine statutory sexual abuse charges on the books which are used to prosecute age of consent and child abuse related crimes within the state. One or more of these charges may be used to prosecute violations of the Arkansas Age of Consent, as statutory rape or the Arkansas equivalent of that charge. The severity of the criminal charge (felony, misdemeanor, etc) depends on the specifics of the acts committed and the relative ages of the perpetrator and victim.
