Flying is the most versatile form of transportation and is available in Creative and Spectator mode. Controls[] Flying is not limited by any processes such as food depletion, which limits sprinting. Flying can be toggled by double-tapping the "jump" key while playing in creative mode (or when the "May fly" permission has been given to the player [Bedrock Edition and Minecraft Education only]) and can be activated at any altitude. The player can gain or lose altitude while flying by pressing the jump or sneak keys, respectively. Holding sprint allows the player to move faster while flying. In Creative mode, flying is automatically disabled if the player lowers onto a surface while in the air. [Java Edition only] In Spectator mode, flying cannot be disabled because players can fly through all blocks. Flying increases the player's field of view by 10%; it is increased further when holding sprint. This may have to be attempted several times before it works.) Speed[] Flying makes the player move at around 10.92 meters/second (39.312 km/h), which is approximately 250% of the normal walking speed, being 4.36 meters/second (15.724 km/h). This is increased further when holding the sprint key to 21.6 meters/second (77.76 km/h). When flying, friction is reduced to a level equivalent to when on ice. A player flying in fluids or cobwebs neither sinks nor slows down. That's all you need. If you are playing on a device where you can't enter commands via chat, you'll have to start a new game with Create new world and make sure that the game mode is set to Creative before you begin. On a keyboard, that's the Space bar, while on Xbox, it's the A button, and on PlayStation, it's the X button. Step 3: After you start flying, you'll need to learn how to navigate. Press and hold the Jump button to move upward. You should be able to adjust your flight with the Directional buttons as you move. Pressing Down or the left Shift key should move you downward. How to fly in Minecraft with Survival modeIf you take Minecraft seriously and want to completely avoid Creative mode, you still have an option to fly -- but it's a lot harder and will take a lot more time. You'll need to get a very special item called an Elytra. Here's what to do. Step 1: Travel to The End and find an End city. It's easier said than done! In most cases, you'll have to defeat the Ender Dragon, which will create two portals. One of those portals will take you to the End islands to explore. Here you can find End cities -- sprawling, almost fungal cities that are hard to miss. Now find a tall space to jump off of and, when in the air, press the Jump button. You should start flying. This is not Creative mode flying; it's more like using a hang glider. People have used firework rockets to give themselves another boost at this point, but it's not necessary unless you really want to see how far you can fly. In "Minecraft's" Creative or Spectator modes, you can fly by double-tapping the jump button. In Survival mode, you'll need to craft the Elytra item, which gives your character a pair of angel wings. "Minecraft" maps can be massive, so it's no wonder that many players prefer flying to walking. Flying in "Minecraft" means faster and more efficient travel uninterrupted by mountains, trees and bodies of water. There are a few different ways to fly when playing "Minecraft." In Creative mode, flying is as simple as the tap of a key or button on console. In Survival mode, however, you'll have to earn the ability to fly by finding an equippable item called Elytra. Here's everything you need to know about achieving liftoff in "Minecraft," whatever your style of play. How to fly in 'Minecraft' using Creative or Spectator mode As you probably know, "Minecraft" has various different game modes and playstyles. In Creative and Spectator mode, you're less like a player and more like an in-game god. One part of this is your ability to freely fly anywhere at any time. Just quickly double-tap the jump button — on a computer, for instance, this will be the spacebar. Once flying, you can hack that by equipping fireworks while you glide. To use the Elytra, you'll need to equip your wings to your character's chestplate slot. From there, climb to a great height, fall, and press the jump key once to start flying. While flying with Elytra, be mindful of real world physics. Flying at too sharp an angle can cause you to stall and fall from the sky. And colliding with the ground or a wall too fast might kill you. Important: By default, you'll be doing all your flying in first-person mode. Press F5 (or Fn + F5 on some Macs), or press in the left joystick on your controller to see your character in third-person view. This makes flying much easier. When your legs begin to wobble when gliding with an Elytra, it's an indication you're losing altitude. If you're not ready to go down just yet, equip a firework rocket in your hotbar and use the item. This will give you a big speed boost, shooting you back into the sky. You can, in theory, fly for as long as you have firework rockets to spend. As your player's legs begin to flail or wobble, either plan to lose altitude, or set off firework rockets. When you allow cheats, you can use codes to change your world's mode. When you start using the console box, a simple line like "/gamemode c" enables you to do it. Of course, there's an abundance of codes you can use to stay alive forever, destroy enemies, and make sure never to lose your inventory. Using Minecraft PE on your Android or iPhone gives you limited options when it comes to flying. You should either find Elytra or use a cheat code. If you want to save yourself from the trouble of going to End City, you can fly with the help of cheats. The same process applies when you want to experience flying in Survival mode on several devices. Once you allow cheats, the whole Minecraft world can change its fundamental rules. You'll notice that the hunger and experience meter are no longer visible, and that's how you'll know that you're now in the Creative mode. Minecraft allows you to fly in Survival mode, but only if you change the game mode to Creative. Once you decide to enable the cheats, a new LAN world will become active. In that one, the codes will enable flying, teleportation, and generating any kind of block, only to begin with. It's important to mention that cheats are only available in versions of the game that received the Better Together update. Since PS4 is still not among them, you can use cheats on Xbox One and platforms like Windows 10 and Switch. Now that your mode allows you to fly, here's how you can start flying using Xbox One controls: Press the A button twice quickly to start flying Use D-pad and hold the A button to navigate your flight Use up and down arrows to fly higher or lower Press the A button twice quickly to land. Before you continue with your game, you'll have to ensure that cheats are turned on. Here's how: Open the main menu and select Settings. On the right side, scroll down until you get to the Cheats. Turn the cheats on and exit. When you change your Minecraft world mode, you can use a cheat code to fly. If you jump twice or use F12, it will make you jump higher and start flying. Using jump and sneak buttons, you can control whether you're flying high or low, and when you're close to your destination, you can safely land. Keep in mind that while you have the cheats on, players connected to your world won't be able to get any achievements for any accomplishment in Minecraft. Of course, they could use codes and enhance their gaming abilities, but achievement remains disabled until the end. In Bedrock and Education Edition of Minecraft, you'll have to use a different syntax to enable flying. Mayfly is a command suitable for checking the player's ability to fly. To set player's ability to fly, you should type "/ability." The best way to run a command in Minecraft is to use it through the chat window. For most Minecraft versions, all you need to do is press T to open the window and type any command. If you want to enable a player to fly using the mayfly command, follow these steps: Press T and open the chat box Type "/ability @player mayfly true." Click Enter to run the command The command is activated when you see it in the lower-left corner. When you see Ability has been updated in the left corner, that means that now you're enabled to fly. What Is the Fly Command in Minecraft? Here's a list of flying commands for various devices that you can use to play Minecraft: On Windows, PC, and Mac, you should click the Space key twice. On Android or iPhone for Minecraft PE, click the jump button twice. On PS3 and PS4, tap on the X button twice. On Xbox One or 360, use the A button twice. How Do You Stop Floating in Minecraft?
