Charles Spencer Chaplin was a famous actor, director, screenwriter and producer. He also acted in most, if not in all. First days and career Born by two animators in London, England, on April 16, 1889, Chaplin began younghis career as a performer. His first act as a performer was an "accident": his mother couldn't reach the treble and Chaplin was suddenly taken away from the crowd to sing. Then he started playing a song called "Jack Jones". Chaplin had a hard time growing up. His mother was sent to a mental institution and his father gave little or no financial support to him and his brother Sydney. Charlie debuted as a member of the "Eight Lancashire Lads" and began performing in the music halls of many different places. At 18 he began a tour of the United States with a vaudeville crew. Chaplin signed with Keystone Studios shortly after and asked his brother Sydney to become his manager. He then signed with Essanay and Mutual labels. He founded Chaplin Studios shortly after completing his contract with First National Studios. His latest label was "United Artists", which he co-created with Mary Pickford, Douglas Fairbanks and the famous D.W. Griffith. Chaplin's Romantic Life Chaplin married three times in his life. His first marriage was to Joan Barry. When their one-year relationship ended, Barry filed a paternity suit against Chaplin. It was only after 21 years that the boy proved not to be Chaplin's biological relative, but had already spent a lot of money on sanctions in previous years. Lita Grey was a 16-year-old actress when Chaplin married her. Chaplin was unhappy with the marriage he often hid in his studio until Grey left of his own free will with their two children. His last marriage was to Oona OÀeÀiNeill, who was 18 years old at the time. They had eight children and settled in Switzerland.The vagrant and remarkable works The vagrant, whose image is not complete without the famous toothbrush moustache, bowler and stick, is a figure constantly represented by Chaplin in most of his films. Her loose clothes play a huge role in her personality as a childish but dignified character. He behaves like a decent gentleman, but sometimes he is also mischievous, and gets away with it, too. The vagabond was notoriously portrayed in Chaplin's silent films, and it was only with the release of the movie "Modern Times" in the 1930s that his voice was first heard. Chaplin was famous for his silent films, but his work changed as he progressed as a director. "A Woman of Paris" was the first film in which Chaplin did not act as a protagonist, but as a passer-by. It was her interpretation of a romantic drama about unlucky lovers. Another famous movie he produced was "Race to the Gold", where he met his second wife, Grey. "City Lights" was a memorable movie for Chaplin, shot for at least two years, and was his first integration of sound production into a movie. Challenges and Controversies Chaplin was investigated by the FBI and eventually deported by the government United States. Since then, he has been denied his return. It's all because of his alleged assumptions as a communist supporter during the Second World War. The verdict was final even though he had spent most of his life in the United States. "The Great Dictator" was one of Chaplin's most controversial works. People continued to claim a great resemblance between him and Adolf Hitler, who wore Chaplin's mustache. It should be noted that Chaplin's mustache was only a product of his character, the Wanderer. Despite being known for silent films, "The Great Dictator" was a talking movie, and it sparked much more controversy for transmitting political messages during the war between Germany and Britain. Remembering Charlie Chaplin To this day, his life and work as a renowned director and performer still exerts a great influence on aspiring and current directors. In 1952 he received the rank of "Officer of the Legion of Honor" from the French government. 22 years later, he was chosen by the British Empire as a "Knight Commander". Moreover, despite being expelled from the United States, he once again set foot in the country to receive an Oscar for his valuable contributions to the film industry. Chaplin died on Christmas Day 1977 at the age of 88. His wife OÀeÀiNeill, along with their eight children, was with him in his last moments.
