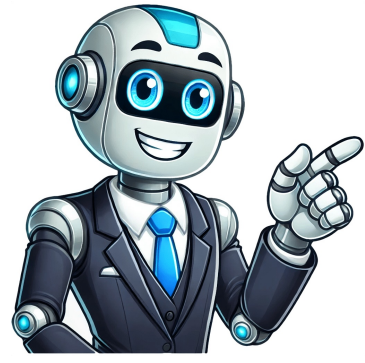

Silhouette portraits have been around since the late 1700s, originating from France as a way to recreate images before photography existed. They were previously known as "shades" and were extremely popular, peaking in popularity in the early 19th century. After falling out of fashion with the invention of cameras in 1826, they resurged in the USA in the 20th century and became a staple at Disney theme parks. Walt Disney fell in love with silhouettes and offered them at Disneyland Resort from opening day. However, it seems they have gradually phased out over time, except for their return at Magic Kingdom. The most popular place to grab Disney Silhouettes is here, where you can find a dedicated cart just off Main Street. You can also experience silhouette portraits in other locations like Disneyland Paris and Crystal Arts Shop by Arribas Brothers at Disney Springs. In EPCOT, the silhouette stand is tucked away in the France pavilion near the fountain. Be sure to visit during less busy times or at the start/end of your park day for a more relaxed experience. The oldest location can be found in Magic Kingdom's Town Square area but it's easy to miss due to its small size and location between China Closet and Crystal Arts Shop. With varying hours depending on location and weather conditions, plan ahead by visiting Guest Services at park opening for scheduled hours. The portrait-cutting process takes just minutes, with single portraits taking under 2 minutes and family portraits (up to 4 people) taking around 5 minutes. You can even get silhouettes of your kids or pets! Artists need a side profile view, so sit steadily or offer pictures if you're having trouble staying still. Get ready for a quick, unique, and amazing souvenir! You can also add a character like Dumbo or Mickey Mouse to the background of your photo if you want, but it's completely optional and adds a touch of magic to your shot. This gives you an idea of what character shots are all about. I personally prefer profile portraits, but check out how cute Tinkerbell is! Disney silhouettes cost \$11.99 per person without a frame and \$19.99 with an oval one. You'll get a free copy as the black silhouette comes folded in half, creating a mirror image that you can keep. It's worth paying for the framed version as it looks way prettier and protects your silhouette better. If you're going on rides, you can leave your artwork at Guest Services or store it safely in your bag. To prevent damaging your portrait, wrap the frame in clothes if you can't store it anywhere. Also, consider tipping the artist who drew your portrait - they deserve it! You might also want to leave a Cast Compliment while you're there (you can do it on mobile too!). If you're a Disney Visa Cardmember, you can get 10% off silhouettes that cost \$50 or more. Unfortunately, ordering Disney Silhouettes online can take anywhere from 2-3 weeks to arrive. To order, send a clear profile photo of each subject to silhouettes@arribas.com. Once your silhouettes are ready for shipping, you'll get a confirmation email! This is great news for those who want a Disney silhouette but can't visit the parks regularly or if a stall closed due to bad weather.
